



## PARKING

Downtown parking is subject to availability. According to our Green Meeting initiative, the Summit highly encourages carpooling to the Summit.

### IMPORTANT TO NOTE:

- ALL garages will ONLY accept Visa, MasterCard, or Discover (no AmEx, etc.)
- Entry will be delayed to process credit cards or make change.
- The National Tornado Summit is not responsible for theft or damage to vehicles or contents.
- The Santa Fe Parking Garage is NO LONGER available for public parking.

### Nearby parking options:

#### Surface Lot 320 – FREE for NTS attendees on March 5 and March 6

- Between Thunder Drive and S. Harvey, Entrance off Reno
- First Come, First Served - Space is limited!
- **Thanks to the sponsor, Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management**, this lot is available to NTS attendees for free and will accommodate larger vehicles.

#### Cox Convention Center Garage - \$10 event parking (24 hour period) – pay when enter

- 1 Myriad Gardens, Entrance off S. Robinson and E.K. Gaylord
- Be sure to enter the correct lane (*separate lanes for cash only or credit card*)

#### Century Center Garage - \$10 event parking (24 hour period) – pay when enter

- 100 W Main, Entrance off Sheridan

#### Sheridan/Walker Garage- \$10 daily parking (24 hour period) – pay when exit

- 501 W Sheridan, Entrance off Walker and Sheridan

#### Arts District Garage - \$10 daily parking (24 hour period) – pay when exit

- 431 W Main, Entrance off Main and Colcord

#### Reno Surface Lot - \$10 **CASH ONLY** event parking (24 hour period)

- SE corner of Reno and E.K. Gaylord, Entrance off east bound Reno

### ***A few more helpful hints on parking:***

As a modern metropolitan community on the rise, OKC has numerous construction projects underway downtown...please pardon our city's progress! We **strongly encourage** those driving in each day to allow for ample time for downtown street construction (check out the [OKC Downtown Traffic Advisory interactive map](#) for details) as well as the likelihood of lines of cars entering parking garages.

Obviously because of its convenience, you should expect the heaviest traffic at the parking garage under the Cox Convention Center. We are encouraging you to include a little extra time in your travel plans, just in case there are delays.

If you are staying at the host hotel, Renaissance OKC Convention Center Hotel & Spa, you may want to consider valet parking; they have both day and overnight rates.
